The College acts in accordance with legislation from the Regulated Health Professions Act (RHPA) and the Dental Hygiene Act (DHA) of 1991. As the College looks to the future, it seeks to appoint a Registrar & Chief Executive Officer to lead the College through its next stage of growth and success.

Reporting to the College's Council, the CDHO is seeking an outstanding leader to fulfil the strategic mission of the College.
